

# Vote 2020!

Thrive Alliance encourages all eligible voters to be engaged citizens and exercise your right to vote. Voting is a 2-step process: 1) get registered, and 2) cast your ballot. While voting laws are quite detailed, the basics are pretty simple:

**1. Confirm Your Voting Status.** Even if you have voted before, make sure you are successfully registered to vote in this election. Check your status online or through your county clerk.

Update your voter information if you have moved or changed your name since you registered.

**If you are not listed as “Active” you need to register.**

**2. Register.** Register online with an Indiana driver’s license or Indiana State Identification Card. You can also fill out this form and mail it or bring it to your county clerk’s office. **Deadline: October 5.**

**3. Vote.** There are several ways you can vote:

- a) **Vote In-Person on Election Day.** On November 3 go to your voting location and cast your vote in person. Polls are open 6:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m. **Remember to bring a valid Indiana driver’s license or Indiana State Identification Card with you. If you don’t, you can request a provisional ballot.**
- b) **Vote by Absentee Ballot.** If you have one of the approved list of reasons, you can request an absentee ballot online or return this form to your county clerk. **Deadline to request an absentee ballot is October 22. Mailed ballots must be postmarked no later than November 2 and delivered to the county clerk’s office by noon on November 13.**
- c) **Vote Early In-Person.** Starting **October 6** you can vote early. Most counties have several early voting locations. Check online or with your county clerk for locations and times. **Remember to bring a valid Indiana driver’s license or Indiana State Identification Card with you.**
